All papers must be submitted as <u>MS Word documents only</u> typed in Times New Roman, 12 pt., single space, with double space between paragraphs. All four margins must be 2.5 cm. Headings may be inserted using the Heading Style, in a different font size than the text, and bold faced or italicized as needed. Diagrams / Charts / Tables must be clearly labelled and inserted at the relevant locations within the paper, or presented as appendices. As closely as possible, the format should be consistent with the APA style.

Papers must include:

- 2. Name(s) and Title(s) of author(s) [Indicate name of co-author(s) with an asterisk]
- 3. Affiliation(s)
- 4. Abstract
- 5. Methodology
- 6. Results and contribution to literature
- 7. Email address of author(s)
- 8. Mailing address of author(s)
